Guests on the Course

Full Members shall be entitled to six guest on the course within one year. Country Members shall be entitled to three guests per year. It should be noted that any one individual may be introduced to the course on a maximum of four occasions only, under any circumstances, in one calendar year.

A fee of £5 will be payable to introduce a guest to the course, per round, three guests can be introduced at one time, the introduction is the responsibility of the member.

Wednesday Competitions

Members can play during members only times using the ball chute, 8.00am to 9.00am, 12.02pm to 1.46pm and 4.34pm to 6.00pm i.e. no sheets posted.

Alternatively they can reserve a time with The Professional during 9.06am to 11.54am and 1.54pm to 4.26. Members playing during members' and visitors' times should allow for the possibility of slow play.

Senior Section

A Senior Section has been introduced in all club competitions (this will include 1 section in medals) with the exception of Open Competitions.

To enter you must advise the starters as to your intention on the day, i.e. to play in the Senior Section of the full competition.

You must be aged 65 or over to enter, you will be able to play from the box tee's with your full handicap and your score will count for handicap purposes. There will be 1 handicap prize per competition.

Competition Sheets

Competition Sheets will be posted on the notice board on the 15th of each month, one month in advance. Please ensure you only place your own name on the competition sheets.

Members who place their name on the competition sheets and fail to turn up on the competition day, will automatically miss the following Saturday's competition i.e. if you fail to turn up on Saturday, Sunday or Wednesday's competition you will miss the following Saturday's competition. This will also apply to competitors failing to enter their scores, this includes no returns, at the end of their round.

Cancellations should be made on the sheet by the evening prior to the competition, or by phone calls to the Professional's Shop prior to your tee-time on the day of the competition.

This decision is final, any exceptional circumstances will be the decision of the Match/Handicap committee.

Members are encouraged to book tee times with the Professional within the times stipulated. Otherwise no bookings; members and visitors can both put balls in the chute.

Etiquette

Priority On The Course/Slow Play:

A single player is classed as a group and has the same status as other groups. Two ball matches should have precedence of and be entitled to pass any three or four ball match. Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a short round. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass. Have in mind that slow play can destroy the pleasure of the game for other players. It can easily be avoided by always being ready to play your ball as soon as it is your turn, by reducing the number of practice swings taken and spending less time over lining up putts.

Consideration for Other Players:

No player should play from the tee until the party in front have played their second strokes and are out of range, nor play up to the putting green until the party in front have holed out and moved away.

Care Of The Course:

The tee is the one place on the course when you should not replace divots. Keep trolleys off tees and greens.

When taking practice swings, players should avoid causing damage to the course, particularly the tees, by not taking divots.

All divots taken on the fairway must be replaced and well trodden in. Pitch marks on greens should be carefully repaired at all times.

Players must carefully rake all holes and footmarks made by them in a bunker.

Dress Code:

Golf shoes are permitted in locker room and access only.

Day shoes must be worn in all other areas. Hats, caps, swim wear, football shirts and football shorts are not permitted. Tailor shorts are acceptable.

Reciprocal Arrangement:

We currently hold Reciprocal Arrangement's with Dunaverty, Carradale, Shiskine and Ballycastle, please ensure you notify the Reciprocal Club when you are booking that you are a member of Machrihanish Golf Club. As a courtesy please take your membership booklet with you and show this on arrival..
