## Get Competition Dates in Google Calendar

Anyone can now see Machrihanish Golf Club's Competitions on their Mobile Phone, Tablet, PC or MAC using "Google Calendar" free of charge.

The 4 separate calendars enable golfers to subscribe to only the type of competition types they are interested in seeing, thus avoiding calendar clutter.

### How To "Subscribe" (Free Of Charge) to a MachGolf Calendar

**Navigate to Google Calendar using a browser (eg:Chrome, Firefox, or Internet Explorer)**

Click on the Arrow to the right of Other Calendars on the left pane.

Click on Add by URL, in the drop down.

Copy and Paste the URL for the calendar you require above into the URL Box.

**DO NOT** check Make the Calendar Publicly accessible.

Click on Add Calendar.

Go Back to your Calendar.

Click on the Calendar you have added, then click on the arrow to the right of it and choose the colour you would like the competitions to be displayed.

**Having subscribed to the calendar using a browser, the MachGolf calendar will appear on the app on your mobile devices because they are all automatically synchronised.**

**NB:** To install google calendar on an apple device, search for it using a browser, rather than trying to find it in apples app store!
